Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been great to finally welcome you all to our new building this week. The children have quickly settled in and they have enjoyed exploring their new environment and new resources. As you can see from the Reception newsletter, the children have been making kites and drawing in the style of Picasso.

I also enjoyed teaching them on Tuesday afternoon and we will be focusing on the story, 'Handa's Surprise' for the next few weeks. After reading the story, the children were able to choose their favourite animal to draw. Some of the children were able to experience the teaching kitchen for the first time as well, and sampled the different fruits which Handa put in her basket. We were really impressed with how the children were willing to taste new fruits and describe them. All the children will get the opportunity to do this over the next few weeks.

Both Reception classes have had PE for the first time this week. Changing into PE kits is always a bit tricky the first few times and we did manage to misplace a few pairs of socks and a pair of trousers. Thank you for your patience as we try to reunite your child with their clothes!!

Newhall Nursery opened on Monday and the staff and children have already started to settle into their routines. Our Extended School provision also opened this week and this is proving popular with the children. At Breakfast Club children are offered a selection of cereals or toast with butter or jam and water or milk. There are then a variety of activities available for the children, including board games, reading, drawing and construction. Jo, our Catering Manager, has done a fantastic job this week, providing our children with hot meals and preparing snacks and tea for the Nursery and tea for After School Club.
