Dear Parents/Carers,

Children in Reception have had an extremely busy week this week trying to help Arabella, our new fairy friend. She has asked the children to help her find a new home as people have cut down all the trees in her forest. They have also been outside using our 'Writing Shack' and 'Maths Den' to support them with their learning. We have all been really impressed with their independent writing.

I have also started reading 'Alice in Wonderland' to the children and we made our own 'White Rabbit' clocks and 'Eat Me' cakes this week. I was amazed at how quickly some of the children picked up how to tell '0' Clock times. Over the next few weeks we will be continuing to read the story and complete themed learning challenges.

In Assembly on Monday, I introduced our PSHCE theme for the half term of 'Dreams and Goals'. We will be talking to the children about their aspirations and looking at inspirational people over the next few weeks. The children will also be voting for their School Council representatives in class. The School Council will then meet fortnightly with me to discuss future projects for our school. Our first focus will be to look at how we might make playtimes and lunchtimes even better.

We have had a lot of new children start in Nursery this week, which has been very exciting. They are now starting to settle and beginning to build bonds with the staff.
