Dear Parents/Carers,

This week has flown by at Newhall because we have been so busy, both in and out of the classrooms. I have enjoyed spending some time in lessons this week and I have been very impressed with how confident our children are and how keen they are to learn.

Children in Blossom Class have been enjoying using the garden and practising riding scooters, tricycles and throwing balls at a target. They have been developing their language skills by learning and singing songs together. Snowdrop Class have been exploring the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and using it to help them with their counting and number recognition. All the children sat and listened to the story and joined in with the activities beautifully.

Bluebell Class have been taking advantage of the lovely weather and have been using the school field for their PE lessons. They enjoyed playing circle games and it was great to see all the children joining in and playing cooperatively together.

Reception have been busy learning about money this week and learning to recognise the different coins – this has been made even more challenging for them because most coins no longer have the amount they represent written on them! They have been adding up coins and using them to buy things from their shop.

The children have also been exploring the life cycle of a butterfly and as part of this learning they were asked to draw a butterfly. They were then given feedback several times and had to improve their butterfly in response. All of the butterflies were amazing but we were completely blown away by Imogen's attention to detail and perseverance.



As the weather is getting warmer, please find a summary of our 'Sun Safe Policy below:

- Parents are encouraged to apply Factor 50 sunscreen before school.
- Children are encouraged to wear a 'sun hat' when out at play and for sports lessons.
- Children will be encouraged to sit in the shade on high UV days as announced on national weather forecasts.
- Children will be encouraged to apply sunscreen at breaks and lunchtimes their sunscreen will be stored in the classroom and be clearly labelled by parents (they will need to be able to apply it themselves).
- In Reception, children will need to bring sunscreen sticks rather than cream or spray in order to make it easier for them to apply it to themselves.
- Nursery will provide Nivea 50+ Sensitive Sun Cream for all children who attend Nursery, this will be applied before a child goes outside.
- Sunscreen use will be required for summer school trips, Sports Day and other sporting events (Children must have their own supply and apply it themselves).
- Children are permitted to wear UV protected sunglasses when out at break and lunch.
