Dear Parents/Carers,

The children in Reception have had lots of excitement this week with their topic as they were visited by a Bee Keeper on Tuesday. They learnt how to look after bees, how bees make honey and how to make their own wax candle.



Children in Reception and Nursery are also very excited about the caterpillars they have in their classes. The caterpillars in Reception have already created their cocoons and we are expecting the ones in Nursery to transform next week.

Mrs Smart and I attended an Artsmark Development Day on Tuesday. Over the next two years we will be developing the arts across the curriculum and through the enrichment opportunities we offer the children both during the school day and after school. We also welcomed Inspire Harlow to our school on Monday evening, where we discussed how we can work with other like-minded professionals in Harlow to develop the opportunities we can offer together as a group of schools.
