What have we been learning?

After we saw the dinosaur walking through our class on Friday, we have been really excited to learn all there is to learn about dinosaurs. We looked at different types of dinosaurs and their features. We learned about what they ate and learned big words like carnivore, herbivore and what they mean. We sorted dinosaurs into different categories.

In maths this week, we have been measuring and ordering items by length. We have been using language such as long, longer, longest, short, shorter and shortest. Please can you practise using this language at home as well. We learned to use non-standard measurements such as bears and stones and then at the end of the week began to use rulers to measure in centimetres.

We have been learning about healthy eating and talked about healthy and non-healthy foods, sorting them into groups. Thank you for those of you who sent in your food diaries. We used these for this activity. The children have spent a long time discussing their favourite foods.
