What have we been learning?

This week we have been using number bonds to add in maths. We have been thinking about problems such as 13+4 and using our number bond knowledge to split 13 in to 10 and 3 and adding the 4 with the 3. The skill of partitioning is a tricky one to begin with but we have been very impressed with how the children have got on!

In art we have started looking at materials and how we can manipulate them, this week we focused on tearing, cutting, folding and scrunching. We had a go at doing this with different types of paper, fabric and plastic.

This linked well to our science where we were looking at different objects and the material they are made from. The children were particular fascinated by the polystyrene!

Our topic this term is 'Pop-up Books'. As part of this we are learning the story of Little Red Riding Hood so that we can create our own pop-up book retelling Little Red Riding Hood.

In PSHE this week we have been talking about dreams and goals and feeling successful. If there is something that the children do at home or at a club that they are proud of, please tell us and we will add a 'success coin' to their treasure chest!
