



What have we been learning?

- This week we have been subtracting single digits from teen numbers in maths using different strategies like counting backwards on a number line and using our number bonds. The children are beginning to evaluate different strategies that they prefer to use.
- In art we are looking at materials and how we can manipulate them. This week we focused on learning how to tie a knot and plait. Challenging, but fun!
- Our topic for RE is special objects and symbols. The children have thought about an object special to them and written about it. They are beginning to understand what a symbol is, and all chose an animal and a colour which symbolises their characteristics. They enjoyed making an animal flip-book detailing the character traits that they share.
- In PSHE this week we have been talking about our goals and how to achieve them. We discussed the steps that children would have to take in order to be successful. They had great fun following steps to make jam sandwiches!
