What have we been learning?

- We have been looking at 3D and 2D shapes in maths and discussed the difference between them. We focused particularly on 3D and made group posters to describe the properties of them. We then looked at patterns and created our own pattern problems for a friend to solve.
- In RE we have been studying the Buddha image and its features. We then had fun making our own lotus flowers and labelling them with key words to describe their feelings. Look out for them on display when you visit for parents evening!
- In PE the children had fun acting out Jack and the Beanstalk to themed music.
- In science the children have been learning about materials and this week they have been sorting and comparing different liquids such as; oil, orange squash, gravy and honey. We then experimented with mixing some of them together to see what happens.
