## What have we been learning?

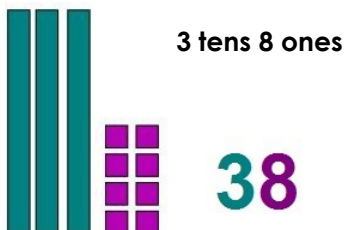
- World book day was a roaring success! The children had a fantastic day filled with dancing, making a pop up scene, making a wild thing mask and writing a description of an imaginary adventure.
- This week in maths we have been looking at the place value of numbers, focusing on partitioning into tens and ones. We have also been practising counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10.
- In PSHE the children have been discussing what choices they make in order to stay healthy. We spoke about the different ways to keep our mind healthy as well as our bodies.
- In science we are looking at animals. The children have been learning to identify and name a variety of common animals including pets and wild animals. We have also touched up upon what the animals eat and whether the animals are classified as omnivores, herbivores or carnivores.
