## What have we been learning?

The children have settled back into school well and it has been lovely having them back. They have adapted to the new routines and changes to their classes.

We read a story about worries and we talked about how important it is to share your worries. The best thing to do with a worry is talk about it. We made worry dolls using lollipop sticks and wool which you can tell your worries to at bedtime. You leave these under your pillow when you sleep and they take away your worries.
