What have we been learning?

- In maths we have been looking at multiplication and division. We have learnt lots of new vocabulary including; groups, equal, array, row, column, sharing and lots more! The children have used objects and drawing to help them. We're amazed at how the children have got on!
- In English we have been looking at the story 'Room on the Broom' and thinking about the characters' feelings. We discussed what 'first person' meant and wrote an account of the witch's day in the first person.
