What have we been learning?

- In class we have started to look at reading and writing our numbers to 10 in words and representing numbers using concrete objects.
- As part of our topic we have been thinking about different royal objects that would belong to a king or queen.
- Science has been exciting for the children this week as they
 have started to think about which parts of the body are
 needed for different activities, as well as looking at who
 helps us when our body needs to be repaired. We then
 looked at people who may have lost body parts and how
 they go on to achieve their goals.
- In RE we started to look at the harvest festival and think about what we are thankful for. The children enjoyed sharing what they are thankful for in their own lives. We then created a class collage of their ideas to make a lovely display!
- Children are now bringing home phonics homework every day- this will be stuck in their book. Please ensure your children bring their home learning books into school daily.
- Mathseed lesson 18– number 0 and ordering numbers. This is live Friday 25th until Friday 3rd October.
- Continue to complete weekly spellings with 'Look, Cover, Write, Check'.

<u>Have fun learning at home:</u> Have a look at the world around you! What is changing about the trees? Children could draw a tree showing what season we are moving into and label it. You could also go for an Autumn walk and collect leaves and conkers.

- Children should all now be bringing a paper phonics book home as well as their library books. Please read with your child every day.
- Remember that children must have their **PE kit** in school and earrings removed for PE days (Monday and Tuesday). Also continue to **label** any clothing your child wears.
