What have we been learning?

- In class we have been learning to compare objects and numbers in maths this week. We have worked hard on understanding key vocabulary such as; greater than, fewer than, equal to, as many as, more than and less than. If you could practise this in context at home that would be great!
- As part of our topic we have been thinking about what we would do if we were a king or queen. The children had some lovely ideas such as keep our world tidy, show kindness to animals and donate our unwanted possessions to those who need it.
