What have we been learning?

- In maths we have started to learn about number bonds and have explored fact families for the numbers 5,6,7,8,9 and 10. Children have deepened their knowledge by representing this with a Part Whole model. See if the children can recall any number facts to 10!
- We have continued to learn all about our senses in science this week we explored sound and touch. The children had great fun playing sound bingo.
- In topic the children have been learning about significant monarchs, hopefully your children can tell you who their queen is and any interesting facts about a few famous Monarchs!
