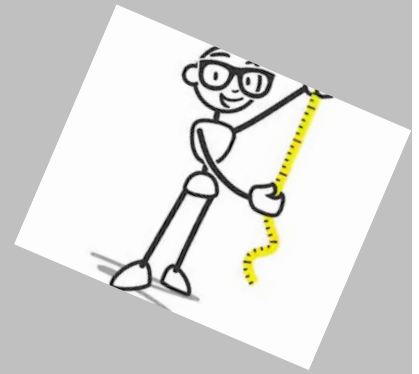

It is important that your child practices their times tables daily, with a focus on 2s, 5s, and 10s.

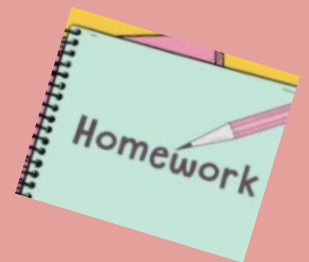


Support Your Child At Home
