Message from the Headteacher:

We have had an eventful week this week, including a walkaround with our REAch2 cluster Headteachers. They were all very impressed with the learning that is taking place in the classrooms and the work that is on display around the school. The children talked confidently about their learning and I was very proud of them all, as I always am.

Children in Year 1 have been experimenting with different solids and liquids. They are beginning to use their scientific vocabulary to explain their results. They have also created some amazing 'Wanted' posters for the 'Big Bad Wolf'. Well done Year 1!
