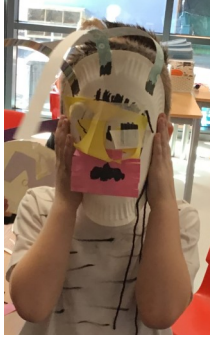


Message from the Headteacher:
