Message from the Headteacher:

It has been wonderful to welcome all the children back to school this week. Everyone has settled back in so well and we could not be prouder of the way that children have handled themselves. Both Reception classes have experienced their first day at school and we are very excited to welcome them all back on Monday. Further to my email earlier in the week, I would like to thank you all for your support at drop-off and pick-up times. The effectiveness of the measures we have in place are under constant review. Please could I take a moment to remind you that there are parking spaces for you to use at the bottom of the road by Smiles Nursery, please do use these to help ease congestion outside the front of the school. The children have started accessing the school library this week and reminding each other of the rules and routines when visiting. If you have any library or book bag books at home, please could you return them to school at your earliest convenience.

We have recently reviewed our behaviour management policy and made some changes. We have been sharing these changes with the children this week. Each class now has a 'Class Tree' which displays our six core values; honesty, respect, responsibility, resilience, reflection and aspiration. Throughout the course of the day the children will be praised for displaying certain values, the child will be allowed to place a leaf on the branch belonging to the value they have been praised for. At the end of the day, the class will reflect upon their tree and children who have their names on branches will be awarded Dojo points which contribute to their house point total. During each Friday celebration assembly, house point totals will be shared with children and the winning house will be awarded the house cup.
