It has been lovely talking to all of the parents this week and having an opportunity to share your children's successes!

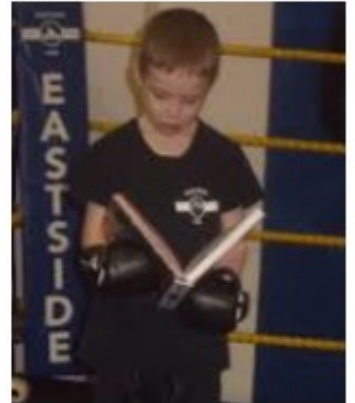
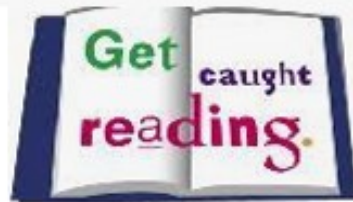
English: Please spend some time this week practising cursive handwriting with your children
