It has been so lovely to welcome all the children back to school this week, and we are pleased to report that the children have settled in well.

English: In English we have been basing our learning around our class text, *The Lost Happy Endings*. We have also been spending some time recapping on all the grammar we have learnt so far, it's great to see how many of the children have remembered lots of their learning from in school before Christmas. All parents have now been sent the login details for Accelerated Reading, on here the children will be able to complete online quizzes after they have finished reading their 'Special Books' which were issued to all children on Monday.

Maths: In Maths this week we have been continuing to practise telling the time. As part of this the children have enjoyed making their own clocks and using them to support them in learning to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past. The children then progressed to telling the time to 5 minute intervals. Next week we will be learning about money, please try and create opportunities for your children to handle coins. This could include paying for small things in shops and discussing the prices of various items.

All children have been issued a library book and an Accelerated Reader book, known to the children as their 'special book' please try to allow time for the children to complete the online quiz once they have finished reading these books. These will need to be returned weekly, on a Monday so that they can be swapped so please ensure that they are kept in your child's book bag.
