

Our Week In Year Three

We have had another wonderful week in Year 3!

English: We really enjoyed our unit on narratives and the children have now completed their own stories based on the Bear and the Piano. This week we have been exploring newspaper texts. The children have been identifying the key features and deepening their understanding of the layout of a newspaper. We have had lots of discussions about what the purpose of a newspaper is and the children have been told that they will be writing a newspaper report about the disappearance of the Bear from our narrative story. You can support your child by encouraging them to read different (age-appropriate) newspaper reports at home.

Maths: We have continued to refine our skills in addition and subtraction. The children have engaged in discussions about, place value and regrouping. Please support your child in maths by encouraging them to practise their number bonds to 20 and their timetables.

RE: This week the children have explored symbols within different religions. Ms Ali (our student teacher) organised a wonderful lesson and brought in religious items with symbolic meaning for the children to see first hand and explore. The children had fun learning about the different symbols and had a go at matching them with the place of worship in which they would be found in.



Home Learning: You will be pleased to know that we have successfully got all the children set up on TEAMs. We received the children's personal log in details today on a spread sheet. We are formatting it to be more user friendly. This will go out to the children next week. We thank you for your patience.

<u>English Home Learning:</u> This week we would like the children to have a go at creating their own newspaper reports. They can write their report on any topic that they like.

<u>Maths Home Learning</u> This has been stuck into your child's homework book. Please continue to support your child with their number bonds and times tables.

Reading: The children have changed their library books. We understand that some children could not remember their log in details for accelerated reader. The children that were not able to take their accelerated reader test at home, have kept their books for another week, in order to give them the chance to complete the test. All children have now been given their accelerated reader log in details.
