

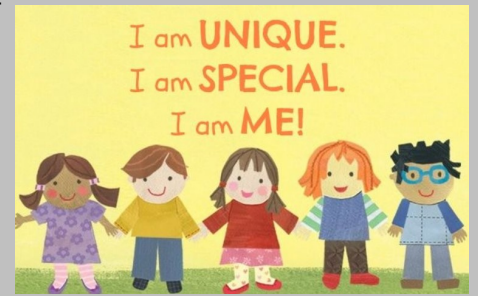
Our Week In Year One

What we have been learning this week...

- English– we have been learning about what adjectives are, what an acrostic poem is and how to make our own acrostic poems.
- Maths– we have been counting forwards and backwards from 10 and learning how to count one more and one less from a number within 10.
