We have had another busy start to the term. The children have started a new Science topic—Living things where they learned about things that are living, dead or never been alive! In RE we have started looking at Easter and new beginnings. With Computing we are continuing with our Coding which the children are really enjoying. We had a break from this to focus on Online Safety week. In DT we have started a new topic called The Wonderful World of Wool where the children will learn all about wool and where it comes from.

Maths- This week in Maths we have started to look at 2D and 3D shapes and learning how to count the shapes and vertices.

English- This week we have started a new book called The Lost Happy Endings and the children have been looking at the features of a fairy tale, the language, good and bad characters and how to describe their own.
