Don't these weeks simply fly by!

English: This week both classes have enjoyed looking into instructional writing. They have explored a wide range of different types of instructional texts, identified why this type of writing is important and developed their understanding of imperative verbs! They enjoyed using this knowledge to play a game of imperative verb BINGO!

Maths: We have spent the last 2 weeks looking at money! The children have enjoyed revisiting how to count money– learning how to systematically count when there are lots of coins using multiples of 10 and 100 to support this process. They have also been adding and subtracting money, then using this knowledge to develop their skill of calculating change. This concept was exciting to explore as some of our children tried to convince us spending money meant we ended up with MORE money than when we started with! If you could go shopping and use cash on occasion, with your children to help support this learning that would be amazing!

Chinese New Year.

We have had a few fun activities to celebrate the year of the Tiger, the children decorated and created their own Tiger origami models. We were fortunate to have a Chinese dance workshop on Thursday, where the children experienced music and dance movement from the orient.

<u>Art</u>

The children had great fun tye dyeing their fabric to make their cushions, there are many exciting and interesting patterns now drying in the classroom. They have explored the difference between natural and man-mad dyes and used their thinking skills to too the pros and cons to using either. We also found out that some beetles are crushed up to make dye- and the same beetles can be used in some types of ice cream!
