

Our Week In Year Three

Friday 4th March 2022



Our first week back, the children are officially halfway though year 3!

English: We have begun this half term with a new novel, 'Charlotte's Web'. The children have been really engaged with this story, and can't wait to find out what happens as we read the story with them. We have been using the narrative to create our own examples of diary entries, first by looking at how these can be created then by thinking about different character's perspective. We move into next week beginning to consider more detailed character description.

Maths: To kick start this half term we have been beginning to understand what 'perimeter' is and how we can calculate it. We enjoyed walking around the painted lines in the playground to help develop this concept. The children have used a range of resources to support their adding of different length and used other key skills like measurement conversion to find perimeters of different 2D shapes.

<u>Science.</u>

We have continued this term with out plant-based theme. This time we are developing our knowledge and understand of what plants need to survive. We have started by understanding suitable environments for plants and why some plants may only grow in certain types of location.

Accelerated Reader.

We have been looking at the Year 3 use of accelerated reader. It has some to our attention that the children use of the online book quizzes has diminished recently. Each child has been bringing home an accelerated reader book suitable to their reading comprehension ability. The books are carefully selected so that when the children answer the quiz after reading the book, their comprehension skills have the opportunity to develop through the targeted questions in the quiz. The children are all capable of accessing accelerated reader and do this regularly at school.
