


# Our Week In Year Three

Friday 10th December 2021



The children have had a lovely week full of learning activities.

**English:** Year 3 finished writing their information text based on Christmas! They have been busy working hard learning the features of information texts, the different types of information text there are and how to paragraph related topics together. All the children have been learning how to create suitable heading and subheading in order to help organise their non-fiction writing.

**Maths:** In Maths this week, Year 3 have been exploring division and multiplication to support our understanding of the three and four times tables. We have been using a range of representation to explore our learning including Deines and counters to make arrays to support our learning.

**Art:** In art this week, children have been busy creating collages based on Pablo Picasso. They have learnt about Cubism and different collage techniques. As inspiration for their final piece, they used Pablo Picasso's artworks, manipulating paper techniques and their own collage designs from last week. They used a range of materials for their guitar based collage and they are really looking fantastic.



**Home Learning:** Home learning is via TEAMS and your child should now be able to access Teams. Year 3 have had a computing session, in which every child was guided through the process of logging into TEAMS. Every child has an email to use to log in (in the back of their homework book). There are a few parents who are still finding logging in tricky. We are looking into individual cases.

**Spellings:** Please continue to encourage your child to learn the spelling pattern rule for week 6: Homophones. Spelling tests are carried out by the end of each week.

**Reading:** Year 3's Library's day is Thursday. We are returning our library books for the Christmas break so any missing books can be identified. Please return any school library book, and any accelerated reader books by Wednesday so it can be returned by your child's class teacher.
