The children have been fantastic this second week back!

English: During this week the children have begun planning and drafting their Iron Man descriptions. They have done really well to be focusing on a range of powerful adjectives and other descriptive language alongside, adverbial phrases, dialogue and writing in the past tense. The will be moving onto explanation text writing next week, still using our core text; The Iron Man as a focus for their writing.

Maths: We completed our fraction learning this week with ordering, adding and subtracting fractions. Most of the children got to grips with this beautifully, and completed the unit with a short assessment. We will continue revisiting our fractions learning during our Maths 'Flashback 4' and 'Get Ready' sections of our day. We have now moved onto time, revisiting and building on the year 2 learning from last year. Please encourage your child to be reading the time and using time intervals at all possible opportunities.

Accelerated Reader.

We have been looking at the Year 3 use of accelerated reader. It has some to our attention that the children use of the online book quizzes has diminished recently. Each child has been bringing home an accelerated reader book suitable to their reading comprehension ability. The books are carefully selected so that when the children answers the quiz after reading the book, their comprehension skills have the opportunity to develop through the targeted questions in the quiz. The children are all capable of accessing accelerated reader and do this regularly at school.
