On behalf of the team thank you, we wish everyone a lovely summer. (For those children still with us through summer we have some exciting activities planned)!

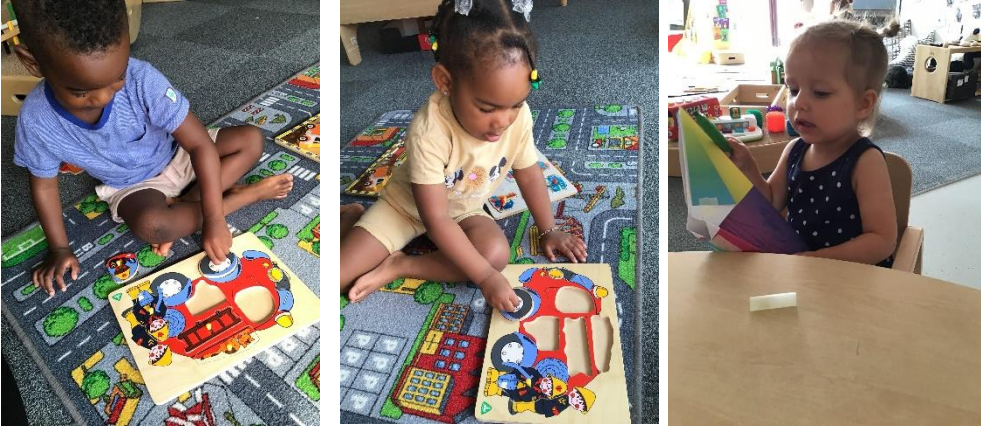
