This week in Blossom we have been celebrating 'Commonwealth Week' by looking at different flags from countries from the Commonwealth and making our own using paint and paint dabbers. We have read the story 'Handa's surprise' and acting out the story using story bricks. We have been filling and emptying contains and using the words "empty" and "full"



Snowdrop

This week in Snowdrop we have been learning all about teeth! We have been discussing the importance of brushing our teeth and sharing our own experiences of going to the dentist. For maths we have been comparing weights, using the big scales to weigh different objects and focusing on the key words 'heavier' and 'lighter'. As it is commonwealth week the children have been making their own flags, we went up to the school field to play some games and had a big race!

We have had a fun week in Bluebell practising for Sport's Day and using this to help us learn about ordinal numbers. We have been learning about first, second, third and last.

As part of the Commonwealth whole school topic this week we looked at the book of Handa's surprise which was set in Kenya. We used real fruit to help us retell the story. This is one of the few books that lots of children did not know so maybe you could add it to your book collection at home or find it on YouTube. The children painted the fruits in Handa's basket and some children tasted the fruits. Orange, Mango, and banana were the most popular fruit.
