





The statutory national closing date for applications is 15 January 2024.

From 6 November 2023, applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

All of the application information is available on the website above.

You must apply by the deadline of 15 January 2024. Even if a parent already has a sibling at the school, they need to apply if they have a child due to start Reception next September.
