Developing Pulse and Groove Through Improvisation In this unit, we ask 'How Does Music Improve Our World?' as an entry point for the broad Social Theme of 'Music Is a Changemaker'.	 This half term, we will be focussing on Bollywood Dance. Children will be working on the following objectives. I can perform a dance using a range of movement patterns. RE	French	Key Information for Half-term
In RE, Year 4 will be learning about Buddhism. They will deepen their knowledge of the Eightfold Path by looking at two specific Buddhist beliefs: 1) Everything changes and people do not want it to. 2) Suffering is caused by selfishness. They will have a range of discussions regarding their own opinions about these beliefs, why Buddhists believe this, and if they can generate any examples of change in their own lives.
